Size Requirements:

No tree measuring less than 1 1/4" in diameter of trunk one foot above ground may be planted on the City boulevard. The lowest branch shall not be over 9 1/2 feet from the ground. It must be a single stem trunk.

Duty to Trim Trees:

It shall be the duty of all persons, whether owners or tenants, to keep the shade trees along the public streets and avenues adjoining such property trimmed in such a manner that such trees shall not interfere with travel on said streets, avenues, and sidewalks.

Tree Spacings:

Trees shall be planted 12' (feet) from driveways and alleyways. The spacing shall be at least 25' (feet) from existing trees. On corner lots, the trees shall be planted 40' (feet) from the point of intersection of the curbs. The City Forester shall have the right to approve variances from the above requirements where conditions necessitate.

The City Forestor must stake where all trees must be planted



Planting Specifications



- A. Trunk Flare.
- B. Pit at least 24" wider than root ball.
- C. Root ball resting on undisturbed soil,
- D. Top of root ball at existing grade or slightly higher in poorly drained soils (3' Maximum above grade).
- E. Burlap, wire, and twine cut away and removed from top half of the root ball.
- F. Gently pack backfill using water to settle soil around root ball.
- G. Saucer around edge of pit (for non-irrigated sites only).
- H. Shredded hardwood mulch 2-4" depth, Keeping mulch 2-4" away from trunk.
- I. Stake only when necessary using flexible ties and drive the stakes into undisturbed soil.
