

City of West Fargo special assessments overview





SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

- Financing method established in Chapters 40 -22 and 40-23 of the North Dakota Century Code
- Designates a unique charge that municipality can assess against property for certain public projects
- Charge is levied against a specific geographic area known as a special assessment district.
- Can only be levied against property which have been identified as having received a direct and unique "benefit" from the public project.





TYPES OF IMPROVEMENTS

- Construction of water supply system or a sewerage system (sanitary/storm)
- Improvement of municipal street system
- Improvement boulevards and other public places
- Acquiring necessary land and easements and construction of necessary works for flood protection
- Acquiring of leasing of property and easements and construction of facilities for motor vehicles
- Capital improvement planning





ASSESSMENT ALLOCATIONS

- Front Footage typically used for local sewer, water and street improvements
- Square Footage typically used for local storm/drainage improvements
- Equivalent Unit(s) typically used for any type of improvement on a regional level
- Some improvements districts are unique and require a variation or combination of these methods.



PROCESS

- Street Improvement Projects
 - Public can protest the creation of a special improvement district
- Other Improvement Projects
 - Public cannot protest the creation of a special improvement district
- Assessment allocations can be protested at the Special Assessment Committee and City Commission





PROCESS

Creation Of Improvement District^{1,2}

Set by City Commission to include properties that benefit from the project.



Engineer's Report And Estimated Cost^{1,2}

Includes general nature, purpose, feasibility of improvement and an estimate of the probable cost.



Accept Engineer's Report^{1,2}

Filed and approved by the City Commission



Resolution Of Necessity^{1,2,3,4}

Published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the city's official newspaper

PROTESTS

- Submit written protest to Tina Fisk, City
 Administrator, before protest period ends
 - tina.fisk@westfargond.gov
 - West Fargo City Hall (800 Fourth Ave. E., Suite 1 West Fargo, ND 58078)
- Must include name(s) of all owners of the property, address and reference project being protested
- Any person who has filed an appeal may appear and present at the next City Commission meeting after the expiration of the protest filing period





PROCESS

Public Hearing^{1,2,}

If majority of owners in the district protest the project it cannot be funded through specials



Request Plans and Specs

City Commission requests detailed plans and specifications from City Engineer



Approve Plans and Specs¹

Approved by a resolution of the City Commission



Publicly Bid³

Must be advertised in the official newspaper once each week for two consecutive weeks

> Special Assessment Commission meets with staff to determine allocations.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT COMMISSION (SAC)

- Three people appointed by City Commission
- Responsible for establishing benefit and allocating assessment
- City Commission directs SAC to meet when a project is nearing completion

- Amortized over a period of time with interest of up to 1.5 percent above the average net annual interest rate of the bond
 - Streets Up to 30 years
 - Sewer Up to 30 years
 - Water service Up to 30 years

- Legal


